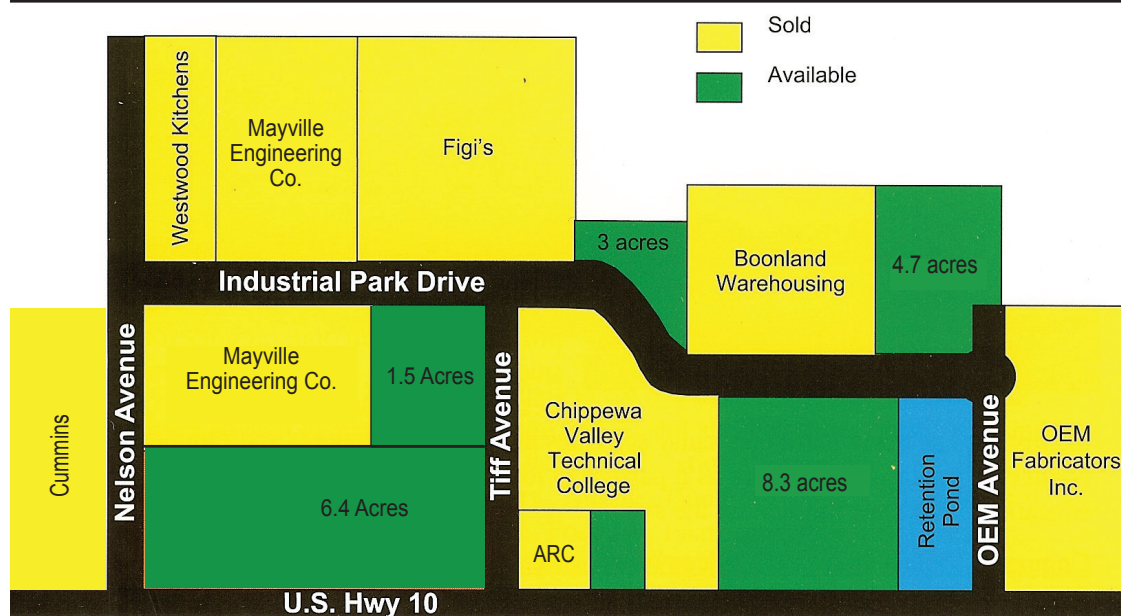


Neillsville... fun in the northwoods!

TERMS–RBF - Revolving Loan Fund

Below market interest rates which may be fixed for the term of the loan. Deferrals of principal and/or interest payments may be allowed for a brief period of time. Terms can be up to five years on working capital loans, seven to ten years on machinery and equipment, and 12 years on real estate. Collateral is required.

Neillsville is a great place to visit or to call home. Located in rural Wisconsin, Neillsville offers many amenities in a small town atmosphere, with the metro areas of Minneapolis/St. Paul, Madison, and Milwaukee all within a convenient distance. Neillsville has a historic downtown, with 20 buildings listed in the State and National Historic Registers. The

downtown area is home to specialty shops, antique shops and restaurants.
