COVID-19 CLARK COUNTY VACCINATION CLINIC (APPOINTMENT ONLY)

Who: Anyone age 18 and over.*

**Everyone age 16 and over are eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine, but Pfizer vaccines are available at this time to those aged 16 and 17.*

What: COVID-19 Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) Vaccines - Administered by Clark County Health Department (CCHD)
This is only a 1-dose COVID-19 Vaccine.

When: Monday, April 12, 2021 - 9:30 AM to 3:30 PM

Where: Clark County Courthouse

(5th floor entrance - South side of building - once in the building, take a left, continue down hallway, room is at the end of the hallway on the left).

Please Note: At this time, there will **not be any appointments available to reserve for 1st dose appointments on Friday, April 9, 2021 at 2:00 PM**. The next COVID-19 clinic will be on Thursday, April 15, 2021, but will only be available for 2nd dose appointments. If you are in need of a 2nd dose of your COVID-19 vaccine (Moderna), please call the COVID-19 Vaccination Appointment Line at 715-743-5105 (Option 9, Option 9).

Eligibility vs. Availability

There is a limited weekly vaccine supply across Wisconsin. It will take time to vaccinate all that are eligible. There is not enough vaccine for everyone in all of the eligible groups. Some vaccinators may have different amounts of eligible availability.

Appointments

- **If appointment slots are already full, please do not call the CCHD or their local partners. The CCHD is not able to keep waiting lists at this time.**
- Please do not arrive more than **5 minutes prior** to your appointment time.
- Sign up for **1 quantity (QTY) per person that would like to receive the vaccine.**
 - Example: There is a husband and wife coming to the clinic together. Sign up for a QTY of 2.
- Please sign up for a time slot by 3:00pm on the day prior to the clinic. Those who do not sign up by 3:00pm are not guaranteed a vaccine.

Appointment Reminders

- Please wear clothing that will easily allow the RN's to administer the vaccine (t-shirt or a long sleeve that can be easily rolled to the upper arm to gain access to the deltoid muscle).
- You will be required to wait for 15 minutes post-vaccination for monitoring purposes. Expect a potential wait time. Thank you in advance for your patience.
- If you are unable to make your appointment due to inclement weather or personal reasons, or arrive after the clinic hours, you will not be guaranteed your dose. You will have to schedule another appointment at a future CCHD COVID-19 vaccine clinic or reach out to your local healthcare provider, pharmacy, etc.

Future Appointments

CCHD may have limited availability at future drive through clinics due to a combination of 2nd dose administration appointments, staffing capacity, and allotted supply of vaccine. Eligible individuals should watch for future press releases regarding new appointment availability.

Those who do not have access to the internet may call the CCHD vaccine appointment line at 715-743-5105 (Option 9, Option 9) starting Friday afternoons at 2pm. High call volumes are expected. Calling and leaving a message does not guarantee you an appointment. The CCHD encourages those who don't have access to the internet to have a family member or friend monitor online resources.
