



I am a potter who has combined the techniques of Raku Pottery, which is Japanese, and horsehair which is found in the desert southwest. Underglaze colors are sprayed on the pot before it is bisque fired. A clear glaze is used on the pot, so the underglaze colors will come through. After the pot comes out of the glaze kiln either horsehair is added creating a carbon trail design or the piece is submerged in sawdust creating a crackle effect.


